

PROJECT NOTICE May 5, 2022

Hot Mix Asphalt Road Resurfacing

Dear Resident:

Rankin Construction is tentatively scheduled to start construction on this project the week of May 9, 2022 including milling, manhole adjustments and asphalt resurfacing of the following roads:

Concession 6 From York Road to Queenston Road
Concession 6 From Line 7 to Line 8
Concession 6 From Line 3 to Line 4
Palatine Place from Circle Street to dead end
Fire Station 4 Parking Lot
Regent Street from Centre Street to Mary Street
Gage Street from Dorchester Street to Mississagua Street
Cannery Trail

Each road will take approximately 3 days to complete, weather permitting.

At times there may be some inconvenience to you during the construction period and we respectfully request your patience and co-operation during this period. Should access to your driveway be interrupted, you will be given notice. You will also be given 48 hours notice prior to a temporary road closure or interruption of services, if necessary (excluding emergency situations). Access to driveways will be restored daily. Work hours will typically be 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday to Friday.

If we disturb your property during the construction, the Town will carry out the necessary repairs as quickly as possible. With respect to seed or sod restoration, please be advised that the Town will water when necessary, however, if you have an opportunity, additional watering would assist in sod growth. Please refrain from mowing the sod until such time as the sod begins to root (a minimum of 14 days after installation). Restoration timing will be dependent on availability of material and weather conditions.
