Dear Transit Rider,

Niagara Transit Commission is busy getting ready to roll out its upcoming changes to the new Niagara Region Transit consolidated transit system, starting Jan. 1, 2023.

Niagara Region Transit will connect all of Niagara through a single transit system by consolidating the existing Niagara Region Transit, Niagara Falls Transit, St. Catharines Transit, Welland Transit and Fort Erie Transit systems into one transit operator.

Although you will not experience any changes to transit services, you might see a change in fare prices and technology helping to align transit fares and services across Niagara.

Leading up to the new consolidated transit system, Niagara Region Transit is undergoing a transitional period to align local transit fares. Please review the following changes:

- The last day to purchase monthly/30/31 day passes is Dec. 10, 2022
- The last day to purchase existing 10-ride passes is Dec. 27, 2022
- One-ride and day passes will continue to be available up to December 31, 2022
- Transit users can begin purchasing Niagara Transit Commission passes in-person on Dec. 28, 2022; however, the passes cannot be used until Jan. 2, 2023
- Transit users will be able to purchase tickets through the Transit app on Jan. 1, 2023

The new Niagara Region Transit will facilitate better access to jobs and services in Niagara, opening up new options for residents in neighbouring municipalities, and new markets for businesses. In addition, it will provide residents with more sustainable and environmentally-friendly public transit options which will help our local environment by reducing traffic congestion and greenhouse gas emissions.
