- Pickleball Courts (1565 Four Mile Creek Road, Virgil Sports Park): Opens the week of June 24
- St. Davids Pool (1446 York Road): Opens June 29
- Wading Pool (25 Picton Street, Simcoe Park): Opens June 29

Additional outdoor amenities and facilities are open and ready for use, including public washrooms throughout the Town, the skatepark, tennis courts, basketball courts, playgrounds, Queen's Royal Park Gazebo, baseball diamonds and soccer fields at Memorial Park and the Virgil Sports Park.
