In celebration of International Trail Day, the Town of Niagara-on-the-Lake and the Heritage Trail Committee invite community members to participate in a special Community Walk on Saturday, June 7, 2025, beginning at 1:00 p.m. at Veterans' Memorial Park at 370 King Street.
