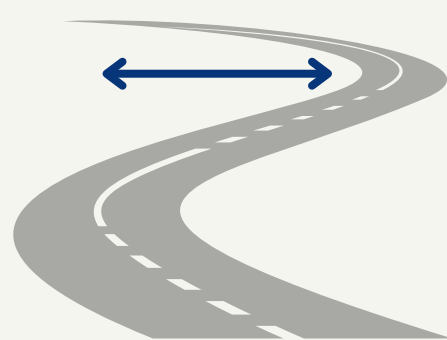


ILLUSTRATED GUIDE TO ELECTION SIGNS

Election Signs can be erected starting **Thursday, August 27, 2026**, and must be removed no later than **Monday, November 2, 2026**.

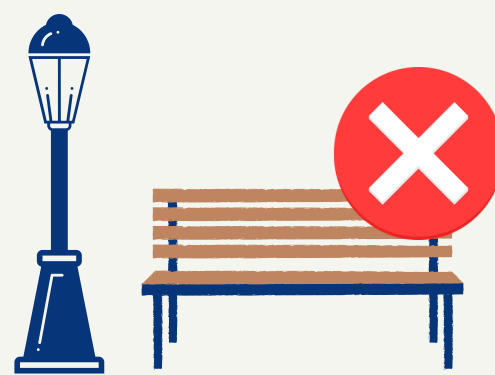
PRIVATE PROPERTY

Election signs are only permitted on private property with the owner's consent and must be setback 1 metre from the property line.



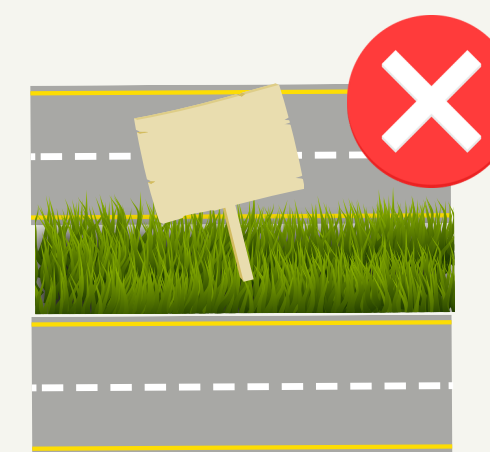
BETWEEN ROAD & SIDEWALK

Elections signs are not permitted between the sidewalk and the roadway.



SITE TRIANGLE

Election signs are prohibited within a sight triangle at the intersection of two roadways.



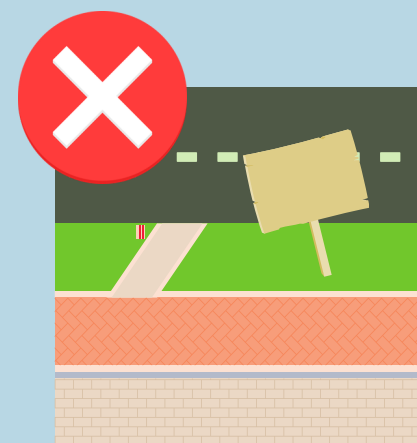
ON/OVER A ROAD

Election signs are prohibited on or over a roadway or sidewalk.



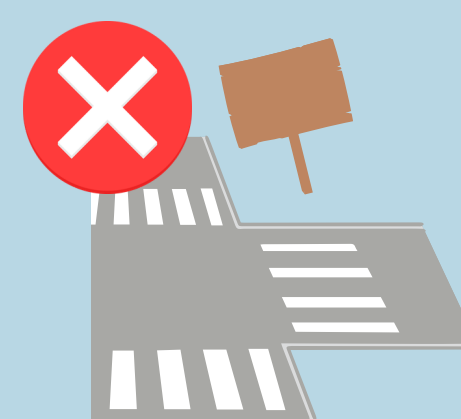
EDGE OF ROAD

Election signs must be a minimum of 3 metres or further from the roadway.



ATTACHED

Election signs may not be attached to utility poles or boxes, light poles, trees, bus shelters, planters, benches, waste receptacles, or mailboxes.



BETWEEN TWO ROADS

Election signs are prohibited on the portion of the road allowance between two roadways.



POLLING LOCATIONS

Election signs are prohibited on premises of polling locations for elections. In the case of schools, libraries & shopping malls, the entire property is a polling place.

PLEASE NOTE:

- 1 Election signs are not permitted on any public property owned by the Town, the Region, the Provincial, or the Federal government, including public parks, roads and boulevards.
- 2 Election signs posted in prohibited areas will be confiscated without notification, and fees may apply to retrieve them.
