# A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 5306-21, BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE THE USE OF MUNICIPALLY OWNED PARKS

WHEREAS The Council of The Corporation of The Town of Niagara-on-the-Lake approved By-law No. 5306-21 on the 22nd day of March, 2021;

**AND WHEREAS** Sections 9 to 11 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, authorizes municipalities to pass By-laws regulating and prohibiting with respect to, among other things, parks.

AND WHEREAS The Corporation of The Town of Niagara-on-the-Lake deems it necessary and expedient to establish certain rules and regulations for the use of parks within the municipality.

**AND WHEREAS** Council adopted a resolution with respect to amending By-law No. 5306-21 to permit propane barbeques in certain parks.

## NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF NIAGARA-ON-THE-LAKE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That By-law No. 5306-21 be amended by removing PART 10: SPECIFIC PARK USES FIRES AND BARBEQUES and replacing it with the following:

#### PART 10: SPECIFIC PARK USES FIRES AND BARBEQUES

- 1. The use of propane barbeques will be permitted in the following parks:
  - (a) Centennial Park,
  - (b) St. Davids Lions Park
  - (c) Memorial Park
- 2. In a Park, no Person shall:
  - (a) light, build or stroke a fire or bonfire;
  - (b) use a portable barbeque, except as described in Section 10(1) above.
- 3. Use of a barbeque must be applied for under a Special Event Permit. If permitted should engage in cooking in a Designated Area and would only be allowed under Permit only, except as described in Section 10(1) above.
- 2. This By-law shall come into force and take effect immediately upon the passing thereof.
