BY-LAW NO. 4512C-22

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 4512-12, AS AMENDED BEING
A BY-LAW OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF NIAGARA-
ON-THE-LAKE RESPECTING ANIMAL CARE AND CONTROL

WHEREAS section 11(3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended authorizes a lower tier municipality to pass by-laws respecting animals;

AND WHEREAS section 128 of the said *Municipal Act, 2001* authorizes a municipality to prohibit and regulate with respect to public nuisances;

AND WHEREAS The Council of the Corporation of the Town of Niagara-on-the-Lake deems it necessary and in the public interest to licence dogs, to regulate and control animals in the municipality and to regulate the care and keeping of animals pursuant to its authority to do so under the *Municipal Act, 2001*.

AND WHEREAS Council adopted the recommendations contained in Corporate Services Report CAO-22-001 to approve an amendment to the by-law to address wildlife feeding.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF NIAGARA-ON-THE-LAKE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That By-law No. 4512-11, be amended by replacing Part V - General Animals, No. 85 to read as follows:

PART V – GENERAL ANIMALS

85. *No person shall feed or permit the feeding of a wild or domestic animal or leave or permit any food or item that can be consumed for sustenance, to be left, or attractants of any type or in any form out of doors in such a manner as to attract, or be accessible by, a wild animal, feral or stray or owned domestic animal on private or public property."*

2. That this By-law shall come into force and effect upon the passing thereof.
