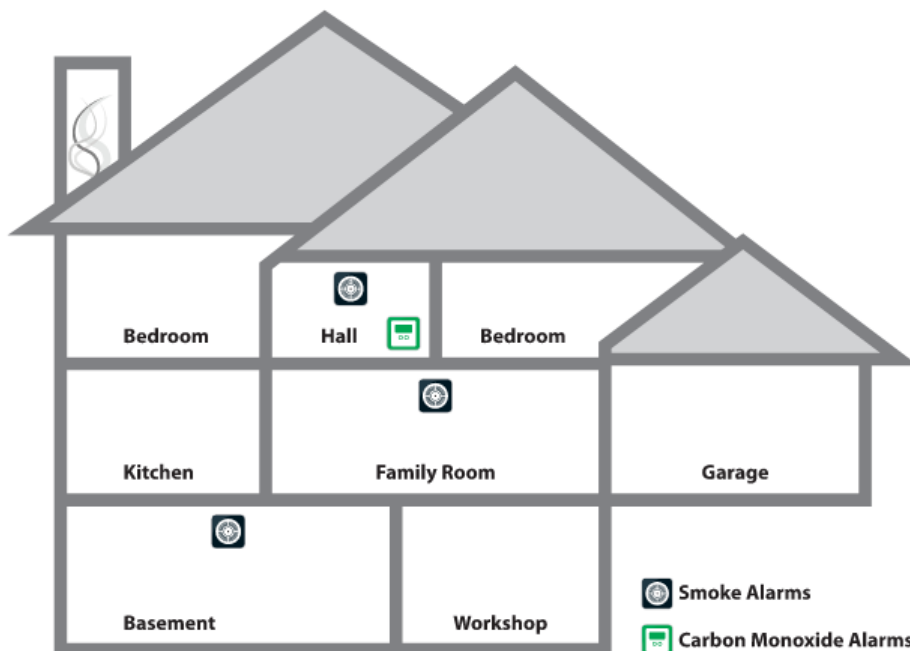




Only **WORKING** Smoke and Carbon Monoxide Alarms Save Lives

Test your alarms monthly!

Smoke alarms are legally required on every level of your home and outside all sleeping areas. For added protection, consider installing additional alarms in bedrooms.



Carbon Monoxide (CO) alarms are required if your home has a fuel-burning appliance, a fireplace or an attached garage. CO alarms are required outside of all sleeping areas in your home.

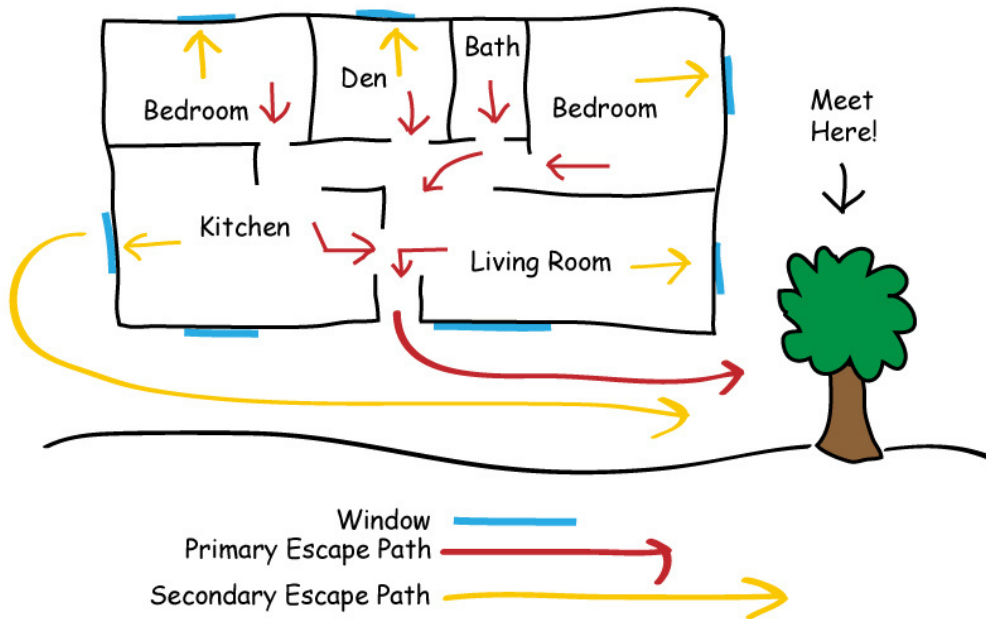
**Smoke & Carbon Monoxide alarms expire!

Home Escape Planning

In the unfortunate event that a fire breaks out in your home, you may have as little as two minutes, or less, to escape safely!

Plan and practice your home escape as a family!



A well-planned home escape should include two exits out of each room where possible, an alternate exit incase one becomes blocked, and a meeting place!
