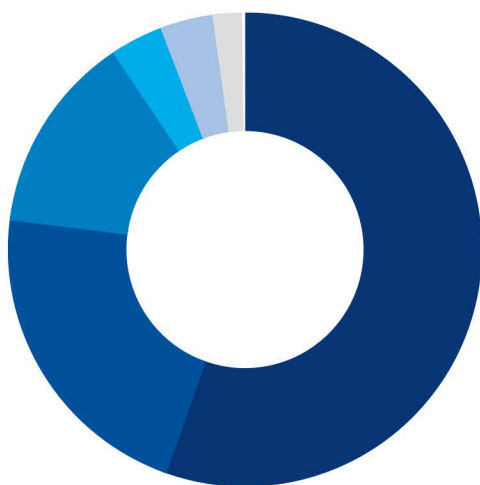


Where do my Property Taxes Go?

- Niagara Health System Services 0.2%

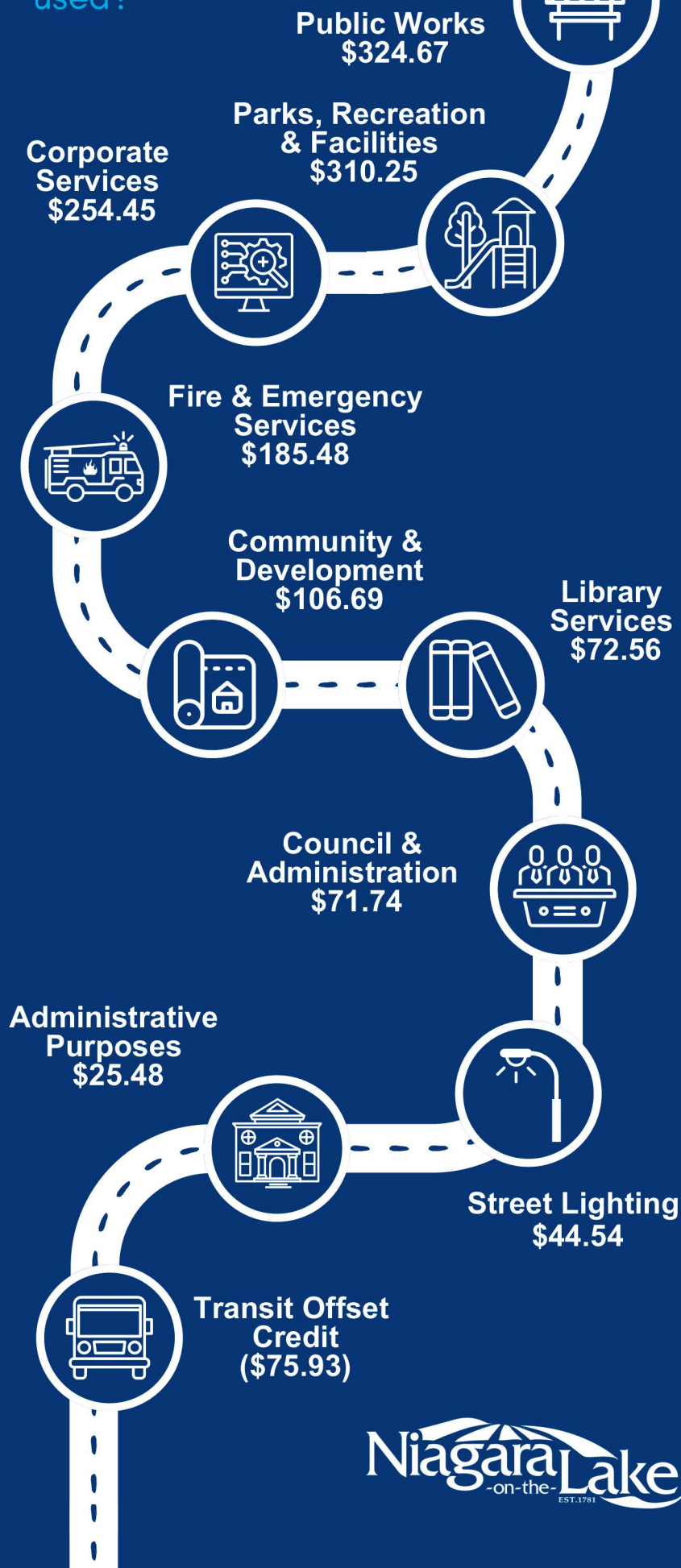
