RE: Annual Performance Report for Niagara-on-the-Lake Sanitary Collection System

As required by ECA Number 069-W601, we provide the following Annual Report for the year 2023.

There were two sewer main blockages encountered in 2023 and both were cleared quickly using a flusher truck.

There was one odour complaint in 2023 that was also remedied by flushing the main.

An annual contract was completed in 2023 which involves flushing and CCTV inspection of approximately 20% of the Town sanitary sewers at a cost of approximately \$100,000.

A capital project was completed in 2023 which involved sanitary lateral repairs by excavation as well as relining of sanitary mains and laterals at a cost of approximately \$270,000. as well as numerous spot repairs and grouting at a cost of approximately \$97,000.

A consultant has been retained to complete an Operations and Maintenance Manual for the Town's collection system but the completion timeline has not been confirmed yet.

A consultant has been retained to complete a PPCP which is in progress but a timeline for completion has not been confirmed yet.

All of the above noted measures would serve to reduce the flow of storm water to the sanitary sewer system in Niagara-on-the-Lake.
