RE: Annual Performance Report for Niagara-on-the-Lake Sanitary Collection System

As required by ECA Number 069-W601, we provide the following Annual Report for the year 2025.

A 250 mm AC sanitary sewer main experienced a structural collapse and was replaced with 27.8 m of 250 mm PVC pipe to restore system functionality and reliability.

An annual contract was completed in 2025 for flushing and CCTV inspection of approximately 20% of the Town's sanitary sewer system, encompassing approximately 22,300 m of sewer, at a cost of approximately \$87,000.

Conducted sanitary sewer maintenance hole inspections using MACP for 55 manholes across the Town, with an approximate cost of \$7,000.

As part of capital projects, 33 sanitary laterals in Garrison Village were lined under the Garrison Village Sanitary Lateral Relining Phase 4 program to reduce inflow and infiltration within the system.

A consultant was retained to complete an Operations and Maintenance Manual for the Town's collection system, which was completed in June 2025.

All of the above noted measures would serve to reduce the flow of storm water to the sanitary sewer system in Niagara-on-the-Lake.
